Policy Statement Sustainable Procurement

MWH Treatment is a leading water sector contractor that specialises in design and construction. Our sustainability objectives are to balance economic objectives with social and environmental stewardship. In order to meet these and our Net Zero Carbon by 2045 ambition we shall engage the support of our supply chain whilst seeking to work in a collaborative manner.

The policy of the Company is adopt the principles of ISO 20400: 2017 Sustainable Procurement. We will:

- Work collaboratively with our supply chain in providing whole life costeffective solutions that are aligned to our sustainability (including carbon reduction) objectives and that of our customers and other priority stakeholders.
- Undertake supply chain mapping to identify risks such as: human rights and ethical issues (including modern slavery and "conflict minerals"); environmental impact; and carbon intensive operations.
- Assess our supply chain partners for safety, health, welfare, environment, sustainable, commercial, quality, design, and ethical sourcing practices.
- Collaborating and communicating with our supply chain to promote awareness of sustainable procurement, manufacture, and construction.
- Be fully committed to sourcing timber and timber products from appropriately certified sustainable sources.
- Regard environmental legislation throughout the supply chain as a minimum standard to be attained.
- To influence the design and selection of materials and equipment to promote low carbon solutions, circular economy and reduce the impact on the environment.
- Ensure the amount of waste produced at each project is minimised by reducing use, re-using and sourcing recycled products.
- Pay our supply chain in accordance with agreed contract conditions.
- Encourage our supply chain to become members of the Supply Chain Sustainability School and to report on their annual carbon footprint.
- Promote equal pay and promote the Living Wage.
- Identify opportunities to employ locally, use local suppliers and develop good relationships within the communities in which we operate, improving the social value of our projects.

Our management is responsible for ensuring that this statement is understood and implemented at all levels of the organisation.

Our employees and supply chain partners shall play an active part in supporting MWH Treatment in implementing this policy.
